TONY LECEMBRI, Manager of the Playhouse Cafe, 550 North Clark Street, advised that he has been associated with the operation of strip joints in Chicago for over twenty-five years. He advised that he knew practically every owner and male employee in such business over the years. He advised that JACK RUBY was never associated in the night club business in any way in Chicago for the past twenty-five years.

LECHARDI advised that he feels that it is likely that RUBY may be confused with one HARRI RUBERSTEIN, who was a successful strip joint owner from 1946 to sometime in the 1990's. RARRY RUBERSTEIN had a reputation for violence and was involved in at least one murder for which he was later acquitted. LECHARDI is positive that BUBY and HARRY RUBERSTEIN were never associated in any way.
